# Pinewood Scholarship

# Scholarship Criteria

## General criteria:

- You are an Australian **citizen** or permanent **resident**.
- Students must reside in or **attend** school in Mt Waverley Secondary College.
- You can **demonstrate leadership** both within, and outside, your school community.
- School initiated **activities**
- You are an **academically motivated** student; or
- You can demonstrate **community involvement**.

## Qualification criteria:

- Textbooks
- Technology resources
- School camps / excursions
- School initiated activities
- Approved external personal development activities

1. Outline the **community initiatives** you have been involved in. You may consider activities both **inside** and **outside** of the college community.
2. How have you made a **positive impact in your community** either outside of school or within the school environment? Provide specific examples to illustrate.
3. Explain what **community** means to you and how community has **impacted your life**.
4. Provide any additional information that may assist the panel in considering you for this scholarship.
