What's involved in participating?

We will assess your child's cognition, problem solving skills, academic achievement, and behavioural and emotional symptoms.

What does my child need to do in this research project?

A researcher will attend your child's school and administer an assessment over 1.5 hours on 2 occasions 9-12 months apart. Alternatively, the assessment may also occur at The Royal Children's Hospital or another public location.
