### Key Points

**All Year 7, 8 & 9 students will require Lenovo Yoga 11e or L13/L390. It is mandatory to have one of the two recommended hybrid devices.**

1. Mount Waverley Secondary College will provide all students with a school email account and storage via Google Services
2. A configuration fee of \$120 per year is required as listed in the Parent Payment Schedule under Curriculum Contribution. This is a contribution to commercial grade high speed internet across the school to improve the delivery of online learning programs supporting the curriculum, server and ICT system costs.
