WHAT HAS HE BEEN UP TO?

Lindsay Mann attended Mount Waverley High School in 1968-70. He started a Maths degree at Monash University in 1971 but in 1972 transferred to Macquarie University in Sydney where he completed a Bachelor of Actuarial Studies. In 1978 he qualified as a Fellow of the Institute of Actuaries of Australia. From 1974-87 Lindsay worked in the life insurance industry in Melbourne and Sydney. In 1988 while working for National Mutual he moved to New Zealand. While in New Zealand he moved from the Insurance/Superannuation part of the business to be CEO of Funds Management. From 1997-2010 he worked in Asia as CEO of Funds Management businesses.

After retiring from full-time employment Lindsay returned to Australia from Singapore in 2010 and in the past 12 years have combined an interesting mix of family, travel and maintains a part-time role as a non-executive company director in the funds management field.
